Verifications Needed to Apply for Supplemental
Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) Food Stamps

Required Verifications:

Proof of identity; Proof that you live in Massachu-
setts; Earned income; Other income; Self-employment
income; Rental income; Non-citizen status: only if you
are not a U.S. citizen (green card or immigration papers;
Child support payments.

Things you may provide, if they apply to you, to receive
higher SNAP benefits, SNAP rules allow you to deduct
certain expenses from your countable income. They in-
clude Housing costs; Utilities; Child Care or Adult
Dependent Care Expenses; Medical Expenses.

Call Project Bread's FoodSource Hotline to connect with
a variety of food resources in your community.

The Family Pantry-Damien's Place can assist with the
initial application for SNAP. Check with the office at the
Pantry for more information.

Clients between the ages of 18 and 50 who are ADAWD's
(Able-Bodied Adults Without Dependents) may obtain
further information at the office at the Pantry regarding
all requirements. Information is also posted at the Pan-
try.
